




General situation



Sulcis (STL) represents only 2,2% of tourism in Sardinia (RAS) but it grows faster





Steady growth of arrivals and overnights




Italians and foreigners



Visitors from abroad grew up by 44% between 2008 and 2009 Foreign tourists almost doubled in 2006-2009

Tourism season

Overnights in May and September grew up by 36% between 2006 and 2009

Most of the growth (+90%) scored by foreign tourists during the same period occurred exactly in these two months

Making tourism independent from seasonality is the way to better spread its benefits on the economy during all the year




Occupation rates
