



24 Great times to be had ...

- Gladstone Pottery Museum. Try your hand at making a pot (or a flower) in this original factory, complete with landmark bottle ovens.
- 2. Apedale Mining Heritage Centre. A rare opportunity to go down an original mine.
- Museum of Iron & the Iron Bridge. Want to stand on the oldest Iron bridge in the world? You can. Don't look down! Set in the beautiful Ironbridge Gorge World Heritage Site.
- Blists Hill Victorian Town. Step back to 1900 and go shopping.
 You'll need to get some old coins from the bank first though.
- 5. Jackfield Tile Museum. The fascinating story of tiles and their use, including an underground railway station!
- Coalport China Museum. Watch craftspeople at work in this original china works.
- 7. Red House Glass Cone. Learn all about glass-making in this magnificent and rare glass factory.
- 8. Broadfield House Glass Museum. Wonderful collection of glass wares. Watch glass blowers at work.
- Black Country Living Museum. The past brought to life in this recreation of an industrial town.
- Dudley Canal Tunnel & Limestone Mines. Boat trips into the huge underground caverns, with audio visual shows.
- 11. The National Trust Back to Backs. Experience family life in these rare survivals of inner-city workers' housing.
- Bournville Village. Explore the 'model village' vision of a chocolate magnate.
- 13. Soho House. The home of Matthew Boulton, one of the world's most influential engineers, with tours and exhibition.
- 14. Museum of the Jewellery Quarter. Wonder at Earth's Riches, an exhibition of jewellery from the natural world, and tour this extraordinary, industrial time-capsule.
- 15. Galton Valley Canal Heritage Centre. Walk or cycle along the 'cut' and visit the pumping house and visitor centre.
- 16. Pen Room Museum. Make your own pen nib and learn about another important Jewellery Quarter trade.
- Walsall Leather Museum. Learn about Walsall's long history of leather working.
- Fradley Junction. Stroll along the canal-side and watch the colourful boats. Visitor centre, nature reserve, a pub and café.
- 19. Coors Visitor Centre. Fascinating history of beer and brewing. Visit the Shire horses in their stables, the micro-brewery and the museum's collection of vintage vehicles.
- 20. Severn Valley Railway. Enjoy a wonderful steam train trip along the beautiful Severn Valley to Bridgnorth. Hop off at time-warp stations and take a stroll.
- 21. Stourport Basins. Explore this original canal town on the banks of the Severn. Lots to do, including a fun fair.
- Forge Mill Museum. Exhibitions of needle-making at the site, including the smallest needles in the world.
- 23. Worcester Porcelain Museum. Collection of some of the most beautiful porcelain wares & factory tour.
- 24. Waterworks Museum Hereford. Imposing waterworks on the banks of the Wye, with its great working steam engines.
